





## JUBAIL ISLAND SET TO BRING THE FIRST GORDONSTOUN SCHOOL TO THE GULF REGION

- Jubail Island Investment Company and Spaces Investment & Real Estate Development signed an agreement with Gordonstoun, to open a school on Jubail Island, Abu Dhabi on 21 September 2023.
- The partnership will see Gordonstoun's unique educational ethos introduced to the Gulf Region, with special focus on character building and skill development for students ages four-to-eighteen.

**Abu Dhabi, United Arab Emirates, 23 October 2023**: Jubail Island Investment Company (JIIC) and Spaces Investment & Real Estate Development (Spaces) announced plans to open a school on Jubail Island in Abu Dhabi, in agreement with Gordonstoun in 21 September 2023.

The collaboration will see Gordonstoun School grant JIIC and Spaces the exclusive regional right to license the "Gordonstoun School" name, trademarks, curriculum, and know-how in the development of the school. The school will comply with Gordonstoun's high standards and reputation, bringing an enhanced sense of excellence and distinction to the region's already-impressive educational offerings.

The agreement was signed by Mounir Haidar – Managing Director of JIIC, Fahad AlBlooshi – Chairman of Spaces, and David White - Gordonstoun Chair of Governors and Chair of Gordonstoun International Ltd at Gordonstoun in Scotland, United Kingdom.

The signing ceremony was also attended by Engineer Abdulla Saeed Al Shamsi – Operations Corporate Director at JIIC, Ali Yassin – Chief Finance Officer at JIIC, Feras Abu Ibrahim – Chief Executive Officer of Spaces, Lisa Kerr – Principal of Gordonstoun, Pamela Muir - Chief Executive Officer of Gordonstoun International, Ralph Tabberer - Gordonstoun International Director, and Jon Longdon - Gordonstoun International Director.

The first Gordonstoun school to open in the region will be in the master planned Jubail Island development in Abu Dhabi and is expected to welcome students in September 2026. to bring this vision to life and look forward to welcoming students to Jubail Island's Gordonstoun School in just a few years' time."

The Jubail Island school will operate under the Gordonstoun name and will bring the benefits of Gordonstoun's world-renowned character education to the region. The collaboration will contribute to Abu Dhabi's leading status – and with Jubail Island being the leading lifestyle destination – will create one of the region's most exclusive residential communities in the heart of the capital. Its presence in the development also serves as a testament to the forward-thinking nature of JIIC and its commitment to delivering a truly exceptional and integrated living experience.

Fahad AlBlooshi, Chairman of Spaces, added: "Partnering with JIIC and Gordonstoun on the launch of the first Gordonstoun School in the region is an incredible opportunity that will see the foundations laid for a new kind of education. Following the English GCSE and A Level curriculum, Gordonstoun teaches students resilience and confidence in the face of challenges.

David White, Chair of Governors and Chair of Gordonstoun International Ltd, said: "At Gordonstoun, we are world-leading in the education delivered to our students and it has always been our vision to make our unique approach more universal. This agreement is a big step towards making a Gordonstoun education more widely available to students in the Region, and we are delighted to open up this unique form of learning to other parts of the world. Gordonstoun is a not-for-profit independent boarding school which was established in Moray, Scotland in 1934 by Dr Kurt Hahn. He founded the school with the ideal of developing better world citizens equipped to contribute to society. Dr Kurt Hahn was the driving force behind the Outward-Bound Movement and also worked with former pupil Prince Philip to establish The Duke of Edinburgh's Awards. Gordonstoun has been a pioneer of character education which, as well as academic subjects, includes outdoor activities, sailing and service to the community. Three generations of British Royalty were educated at Gordonstoun including King Charles III. Approximately one third of the pupils at the coeducational boarding school receive fees assistance in order to attend. The school was described as 'outstanding' and 'sector-leading' in its most recent inspection and was voted the best boarding school in the UK in 2021.
